    1. Judicial Board now consists of only one member from each chapter, no longer two
    2. Recruitment Executive Board
      - a) The only required members from the Panhellenic Executive Board to serve on Rec Exec (and be in Gainesville full time for the designated Summer term): President, Executive Vice President, Membership Vice President, and Assistant Membership Vice President

- b) The positions of Finance Vice President, Communications Vice President, Activities Vice President, and Assistant Activities Vice President are not required to be in Gainesville for the Summer term
      - c) If any of the individuals in the positions not required to stay for the Summer term fulfill the following criteria, they are considered on Recruitment Exec and are Blue Hats:
        - (1) Served as a Pi Chi during the previous Recruitment
        - (2) Will be in Gainesville for the summer term
      - d) If any of the individuals in the FVP, CVP, AVP, or AAVP positions have served previously as a Pi Chi, but will not be dedicating the necessary Summer term in Gainesville, they will serve as a second year orange hat during recruitment.
      - e) Any assistant position is not considered a blue hat (AAVP, AMVP, Asst. Computer)
    - 3. Sister Support Ambassadors will now serve as its own committee under the Executive Vice President
      - a) Will no longer function under the Director's Board
