## ADDITIONAL NOTES

Tech Fee is for the maintenance of the Delta Gamma website and covers expenses for the recruitment program.

Greekbill Fee is the yearly charge of services from greekbill. Charges are calculated based on the members with active Greekbill accounts.

Our Dues & Fees and Housing Costs are split into two contracts. Our members sign two contracts and make payments on both contracts. The totals above include all costs across both contracts.

## FAQs

**1. Are your chapter women required to live in the chapter facility?**

- Yes. Every member is required to live in house at least one year. Filling the house begins with a first come, first serve basis. If there are still empty beds, the house is filled on a point basis outlined in our bylaws.

**2. Is your meal plan required?**

- Yes. Lunch and Dinner are provided Monday-Friday. No meals on Saturday. Just dinner on Sunday. Breakfast is served Monday-Friday for in house girls only. Snacks are available everyday with a maximum of 2 snacks per day per person. In house women have unlimited snacks per day. If you have an allergy our kitchen is very accommodating with gluten free, vegan, and vegetarian options. If you are not satisfied with the kitchen handling your allergy, our housing board is very willing to eliminate your meal plan and its costs for you.

**3. Does your national organization offer scholarships?**

- Yes, both need based and merit based. The application is online for both and available to all good-standing members.

**4. Do you offer a payment plan?**

- Members have the option to choose monthly, semesterly, or in full. Every member is assigned a payment plan of their choosing and they must make payments according to this plan to be in good financial standing with the chapter.
