ADDITIONAL NOTES

- NPC Fee is a required fee from Kappa Alpha Theta Nationals for each member to be recognized as a member of the sorority.
- Board Fee is how we refer to chapter's meal plan. We provide lunch and dinner Monday through Friday each week. Members residing in-house also receive breakfast Monday through Friday. The meal plan is mandatory as apart of all members' dues.
- Our dues & fees are split into two categories to make payments. "FHC Dues" include the usage fee (room fee if residing in-house), board fee (meal plan), and facility fee that are paid to the Fraternity Housing Corporation. "Chapter Dues" include the sisterhood fee, philanthropy fee, social/special events fee, per capita fee, initiation fee, NPC fee, and panhellenic fee that are paid directly to the chapter.

FAQs

1. Are your chapter women required to live in the chapter facility?

- No, members are not required to live in-house, the only person required to live in the chapter facility is the president. To select who lives in-house, members express interest in living in the chapter facility via a google form. The facility management director then compiles a ranking of members that expressed interest. The ranking is as follows: the president is ranked 1, followed by executive officers, then cabinet members, then by member class seniority, and finally by amount of points. In the event of a tie, points from fall semester will be used to determine ranking.

2. Is your meal plan required?

- Yes, our meal plan is required for all members. Our meal plan includes lunch and dinner for all members Monday-Friday and brunch on Saturdays. For members that reside in-house, breakfast, lunch, and dinner are all included Monday-Friday, as well as brunch on Saturday. There are no "different options" for our meal plan, but our chefs can provide different types of meals (gluten-free, vegan, fish options, etc.) for members based on individual dietary needs that are communicated with them.

3. Does your national organization offer scholarships?

- Yes, our nationals offers multiple scholarships to members, including both merit and need-based scholarships. The chapter outlines how to apply and the deadlines of each scholarship as they become available throughout the year. The chapter offers aid in applying for the scholarships by giving members the ability to review applications and answer questions periodically throughout the application cycle. Kappa Alpha Theta prides itself on the quantity of scholarships offered and its drive to reward girls of all different backgrounds who apply.

4. Do you offer a payment plan?

- All of our members are automatically billed using a monthly payment plan where FHC dues are broken up into 4 separate monthly payments of \$339, and chapter dues are paid one time per semester all at once. Members can always choose to pay all dues in full at the beginning of the semester if they would rather do it in one payment.
