- Badge Fee:** One-time payment for badge of membership (amount of the badge depends on the style of badge)
- National Collegiate Dues:** Paid throughout the member's collegiate membership in the Fall term
- Parlor Fee:** Money collected for house/suite/chapter room supplies and maintenance charged to members not living in-house
- Financial Services Fee:** Fee collected on behalf of the housing corporation financial representatives of the chapter
- Facility Fees:** Fees regarding the up-keeping and maintenance of the chapter house

FAQs

1. Are your chapter women required to live in the chapter facility?

- No, members are not required to live in the chapter facility. If a member chooses to live in the chapter facility, they will complete a housing contract with the Corporation Board and provide necessary deposits. The housing contract is for an entire school year, and if members choose to live in the chapter facility again, another contract will need to be filled out for the following school year. Housing contracts will stop being distributed once the house is full.

2. Is your meal plan required?

- Yes, the meal plan is required for all full-time, active members. Should a member seek a different status other than full-time during their term of membership, the meal plan will become optional. Members on the meal plan are provided meals Monday-Friday, except during holidays and university-designated breaks. Breakfast is only provided for members living in the chapter facility.

3. Does your national organization offer scholarships?

- Yes, the Sigma Kappa Foundation offers scholarships to both undergraduate and graduate students. While many scholarships are designated for members of specific chapters or areas of study, more than 20 are available to members at large. Sigma Kappa at the University of Florida (UF) has its own scholarship through the Sigma Kappa Foundation, as well as a local one sponsored by the UF chapter

4. Do you offer a payment plan?

- Yes, members have the option to either split their payments into monthly installments or pay it all in one lump sum.
