FAQs

- 1. Are your chapter women required to live in the chapter facility?**
 - No. Since we have a smaller house, spots in-house are given out based off of points in the fall semester and then also GPA if points are the same.
- 2. Is your meal plan required?**
 - Yes. We have breakfast, lunch, and dinner for all members during all registered school days. We have a separate sister kitchen for in-house girls with snacks (separate fee). There are some snacks like chips or fruit in the house but it's mainly the three meals. There are no options for the meal plan, we just consider it part of your facility fees.
- 3. Does your national organization offer scholarships?**
 - Yes. We have national scholarships and even a Beta Pi specific scholarship. The Beta Pi specific scholarship is based off your application, and up to the discretion of their committee. For our national scholarships there are both merit based and need based ones. Council shares links to the applications when they release in the fall and encourages members to apply. The application begins with a few essay prompts, and is clearly explained on the website we share with all members!
- 4. Do you offer a payment plan?**
 - We don't necessarily offer a payment plan outside dues being split up into 4 monthly payments. Members are able to pay their account off in full though through BillHighway. If a member needs more time to make a payment, they are able to reach out and let our Finance Vice President know so that they are not in bad standing. We don't have payment options to choose from, but the Finance Vice President has the ability to individualize how much we expect a member to pay based on what they can afford. If they are unable to pay the full balance by the end of the semester, they can consider applying to go inactive for the semester as well.
