## ADDITIONAL NOTES

Our Dues & Fees and Housing Costs are split into two contracts. Our members sign two contracts and make payments on both contracts on two different online platforms. Members have the option to pay the amounts in full for the semester or in monthly installments. The totals above include all costs across both contracts.

## FAQs

### 1. Are your chapter women required to live in the chapter facility?

- No, it is not required. Members can volunteer to live in house and the selection process is determined by how many chapter points they have earned for attending various events. The girls with the most points have the first priority. For room selection, it goes by order of Exec position, followed by seniority, then the point system for those left.

### 2. Is your meal plan required?

- Yes, it is required. Our members are fed lunch and dinner Monday - Friday. If you live in house, you also receive breakfast 2 days a week. There are snacks provided for girls who live in house only. If you have dietary restrictions, the chefs will provide a meal to meet your needs.

### 3. Does your national organization offer scholarships?

- Chi Omega's national organization offers scholarships and grants to both collegiate and alumnae members. The application process and criteria vary by scholarship. Applications for Chi Omega scholarships are usually open for eight week periods. Most scholarships from the national organization require thoughtful answers to questions, letters of recommendation, and a resume. Deadlines for these scholarships are generally consistent each year. Chi Omega offers both merit-based and need-based scholarships. The merit-based scholarships recognize academic achievement and leadership. The need based scholarships provide support for members facing financial troubles. Applicants for both types of scholarships must be in good standing with their respective chapter.

### 4. Do you offer a payment plan?

- Yes, our dues can be split up into monthly installments.
