ADDITIONAL NOTES

Empty Bed Fees (EBF): Members are required to live in-house at least one year. If there are empty spots in the chapter facility, members who have not lived in house are required to pay an EBF. New Members are excluded from this fee. The fee is set by headquarters and billed to the chapter, therefore it is split between all members who have not lived in house.

Corporation Fees: The entire membership has access to the house and thus the property is subject to a great deal of wear and tear. The corporation fee is used primarily for care and maintenance of the property. The meal plan is required for all members and therefore is combined with other facility fees and billed as one fee by Properties. We as a chapter are not given a split of how much goes towards each separate item.

FAQs

1. Are your chapter women required to live in the chapter facility?

- Members are required to live in house for at least one year out of their time with the chapter. If they choose not to live in house, members will be required to pay empty bed fees which is an amount that is billed to the chapter from properties and then billed out to members who have not fulfilled the requirement. Once you've lived in house for one year, you will not be charged any empty bed fees. The amount that members are charged changes every year depending on how many empty beds there are in the house.

2. Is your meal plan required?

- Yes our meal plan is required as a part of the Corporation Fee. Members are fed lunch and dinner Monday through Thursday, with lunch on Friday's and dinner on Sunday's. Breakfast is provided only for in-house members Monday-Friday. Snacks are provided to in-house members throughout the weekend. There are also gluten-free, vegetarian, and dairy free options available during the week for meals.

3. Does your national organization offer scholarships?

- Nationals offers merit-based scholarships to members. They are however only applicable to academic needs such as books, tuition, and any fees that are education related. Funds may not be used for any local or international Alpha Omicron Pi Fraternity dues/fees, including AOII Housing.

4. Do you offer a payment plan?

- Payment plans are not official, however, done in extreme circumstances to help out the women of our chapter who reach out to us due to any financial hardship. It varies per member to provide the best help for each of their situations. We only have about 4 girls on payment plans right now. For example, one member pays a certain amount every Friday, whereas another pays a certain amount biweekly.
