ADDITIONAL NOTES

Our insurance and NPC dues are only required once a year. These dues are facilitated by the Pi Beta Phi national organization and helps fund international fees, local chapter fees, and national housing/insurance costs.

Any special assessments such as merchandise is bought at the members' discretion.

For chapter women who wish to study abroad, we offer a remote status in which members pay a discounted amount when they are away. We also offer payment plans for members to apply to if they cannot pay their dues in one installment.

FAQs

- 1. Are your chapter women required to live in the chapter facility?**
 - Our chapter women are not required to live in house. We offer spots to all members and select spots based on points and involvement within the chapter!
- 2. Is your meal plan required?**
 - Yes! Our meal plans are required and include lunch and dinner five times a week, two meals a day. We offer special dietary needs options and offer snacks throughout the week!
- 3. Does your national organization offer scholarships?**
 - Yes! We offer various scholarships which are decided through merit and need-based offerings.
- 4. Do you offer a payment plan?**
 - Yes! Our payment plan includes three installments, due the last day of the first three months and offered to those who apply.
