## ADDITIONAL NOTES

**Capital Improvement Fees:** dues that go to Executive Office that enable us to renovate our facility, fix any damages to our facility, and improve it overall. Just last summer, we had the ability to redo the back patio of our house!

**Badge Fees:** dues that go towards the pin initiated members receive on initiation day. New members have the option to choose between 10K or gold-plated badges.

## FAQs

- 1. Are your chapter women required to live in the chapter facility?**
  - Members are not required to live in house, but highly encouraged to. Spots to live in house are given to the members who sign up first!
- 2. Is your meal plan required?**
  - Our meal plan is required by all members whether you live in or out of the house. Meals are provided to all members Monday through Friday. In-house residents are provided with breakfast Monday through Friday.
- 3. Does your national organization offer scholarships?**
  - Our Nationals offers a variety of scholarships for members to apply for. Tri Delta nationals covers both merit and need based scholarships. Members can submit online applications and the recipients of the scholarships are decided at the discretion of nationals.
- 4. Do you offer a payment plan?**
  - We offer multiple payment plans to work with members and their financial needs. We have installment plans (with 3 cycles) to help alleviate the burden of paying everything upfront. We also offer payment extension agreements to women who are in financial trouble. This essentially is a plan where the member works with our Director of Member Finances to coordinate a solution throughout the semester/year. This ensures members can pay their dues at their convenience to help relieve some of the burden that comes with strict financial deadlines. We also do Extraordinary Membership Status, which is mostly for girls studying abroad or doing semester-long internships off campus. They only have to pay a portion of the dues, considering they are not on campus for that term.
