- Help develop character, friendship, and personal growth



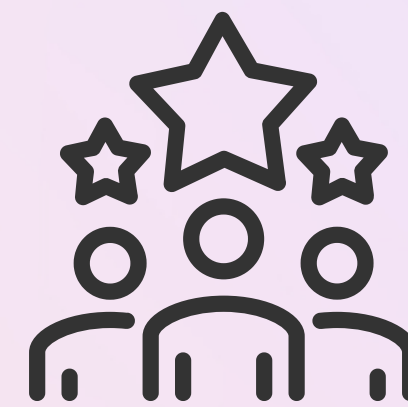

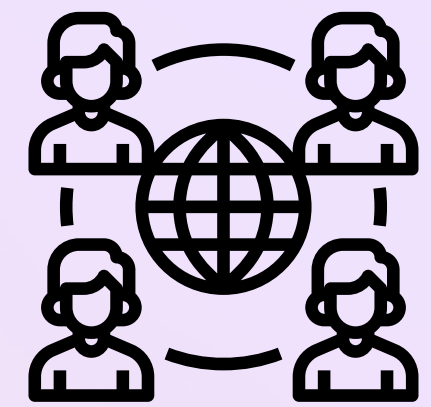

CHAPTER HOUSES

- Each chapter has a House Director (House Mom)
- Members can eat meals at their house, frequency of meals depends on the individual chapter's meal plan
- Most chapter living facilities house sophomores, juniors, and executive boards
- Average number of women who reside in each chapter house is 40-60

Partnerships with Gainesville community businesses for fundraisers benefitting Circle of Sisterhood (Impulse, Yogurtology, etc.)

Around the Row: all 18 chapters participate by bringing food that represents their chapter the Norman Field for everyone to enjoy and raise money for Circle of Sisterhood

INDIVIDUAL CHAPTER PHILANTHROPIES

SERVICE & PHILANTHROPY



Each chapter supports their own philanthropic organization and hosts an annual event to raise money for that organization

Events include paintball, dance competitions, flag football, baseball, and more!

MEMBERSHIP COSTS

- **Pre-Initiation Range: \$900 - \$3,500**
 - Includes: badge/pin, initiation fee, corporation fees, meal plan
- **Semester After Initiation Range: \$1,300 - \$2,300**
 - Includes: chapter dues and meal plan
- **Members per semester (in house): \$2,700 - \$6,000**
 - Includes: chapter dues, parlor fee, room rent, meal plan
- **Members per semester (out of house): \$1,400 - \$3,100**
 - Includes: chapter dues, parlor fee, meal plan
- **University Cost (annual average of double occupancy room) : \$5,135**
 - Includes room and board

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Degree seeking student enrolled in at least one credit hour at the University of Florida
- Did not receive a bid in Fall 2021 Recruitment
- Any specific eligibility requirements can be addressed afterwards, feel free to ask!
