ADDITIONAL NOTES

Badge Fee: Alpha Chi Omega requires that all initiated members have a chapter badge. The badge fee covers the standard badge, but members may choose to purchase one with added embellishments for an additional charge.

Merchandise: The merchandise fee covers required shirts for philanthropy events and recruitment, but members can purchase additional merchandise that the chapter designs throughout the year if they would like! These purchases are optional and will be charged to each member through our billing system.

FAQs

1. **Are your chapter women required to live in the chapter facility?**

- No, members are not required to live in-house. Housing is offered on a first-come, first-served basis, and leases typically run August-May in accordance with UF's academic calendar.

2. **Is your meal plan required?**

- Yes, our meal plan is required. Meals are provided Monday-Friday with additional breakfast and snack items available for in-house members. We offer several options, including vegetarian, vegan, and gluten-free options to accommodate members with dietary restrictions.

3. **Does your national organization offer scholarships?**

- Yes, our national organization offers both merit and need-based scholarships that members may apply for. The application typically includes information about a member's academics, leadership and involvement, and financial needs.

4. **Do you offer a payment plan?**

- Yes. Initiated members have the option to pay dues in three installments due on the 25th of the first three months of the semester. New members have the option to pay dues in 2-3 installments due on the 25th of the first 2-3 months after they are initiated. All members also have the option to pay dues in full in either the first month of the semester or the first month after they are initiated. Approximately 50% of the chapter takes advantage of the payment plan.
