FAQs

- 1. Are your chapter women required to live in the chapter facility?**
 - Chapter women are not required to live in house, but it is highly encouraged! Members can volunteer to live in house and the selection process is determined by seniority first, then by how many points you have for the chapter, your GPA, and other involvement activities.
- 2. Is your meal plan required?**
 - Yes, members can have lunch Monday-Friday and dinner Monday- Thursday. They are allowed one breakfast a week, so a total of 10 meals a week. In-house members have access to breakfast Monday-Friday along with snacks.
- 3. Does your national organization offer scholarships?**
 - Yes! Nationals offers undergraduate and graduate level scholarships based on academic performance and financial need. You must submit a letter of recommendation and transcripts to apply.
- 4. Do you offer a payment plan?**
 - Yes. We have semester or monthly plans. If you choose the monthly option it will include eight installments due the 10th of every month.
